



Photography Policy

This policy is based on the Australian Sports Commission's best practice guidelines.

During the Ballarat Junior Water Polo Tournament (BJWPT) a volunteer from Monash University Water Polo Club (MUWPC) will be taking photos of various activities across the weekend in and around the Ballarat Aquatic and Lifestyle Centre and at the Ballarat Indoor Go Kart Centre including but not limited to action shots during games, quarter time huddles, group shots out of the pool, team shots of finalists etc

Photos taken across the weekend will be reviewed by the tournament director and selected photos may be used on the BJWPT website to document the tournament and celebrate the finalists achievements. Photos will not be used for any other purpose without permission from the subject in the photo/s.

1. **Permission.** The BJWPT Club Entry Form and Team entry forms request that the club entering a team has read and understood this policy and made it available to athletes and their parents
2. **Images.** Any images taken will remain the property of the BJWPT will not be used or sold for other purposes. Images will only be used where kids are wearing situationally appropriate attire.
3. **Access.** Our photographer will be supervised and no photos will be taken in private settings.
4. **Personal Information.** There will be no identifying personal information accompanying photographs, such as the child's name, address or telephone number.
5. **Relevance.** Images of participants will only be reproduced on the BJWPT web site where they are relevant to the weekends events.
6. **Match Videos.** Should any clubs wish to video any matches for coaching or review purposes we ask that they please request permission from both the opposing team and the Tournament Director before the match.
7. **Complaints / Concerns.** Should any club, official, parent or athlete have any complaints or concerns with any images used on the BJWPT website we ask that they please contact the Tournament Director on juniors@monashuniwaterpolo.com.au and they will arrange to remove the image/s and destroy the original digital files to prevent potential future use.
